RECOMMENDATION:

ADOPT RESOLUTION 13-1545 AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH MARICOPA COUNTY FOR DISASTER AND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR SEPERABILITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

PURPOSE:

This agreement helps the City of Goodyear accomplish the Emergency Management mandate spelled out in Title 26 308 (B) of the Arizona Revised Statutes, through a cost shared basis with Maricopa County.

BACKGROUND AND COMMUNITY BENEFIT:

In June 2003, the City of Goodyear entered into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the Maricopa County Department of Emergency Management (MCDEM) for emergency planning and other services. MCDEM assigns an Emergency Service Planner to each of the participating cities and town to help write and update the jurisdiction's emergency plan, to assist them in conducting exercises of the plan, to act as a liaison to the city during large emergencies, and to enhance all of the entities' collaboration in emergency management for shared resources and assistance during disasters.

PREVIOUS ACTIONS AND DISCUSSION:

On June 23, 2003 Council approved an IGA between City of Goodyear and Maricopa County Disaster and Emergency Management Services.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

The shared cost to the City of Goodyear for FY 13-14 is \$4,103.34.
