SUBJECT: Goodyear Youth Commission By-Laws

Summary: Amendments the Goodyear Youth Commission By-Laws.

Recommendation:

Ratify amendments to the Goodyear Youth Commission By-Laws as adopted by the Youth Commission at its meeting on September 25, 2019.

Fiscal Impact: There are no budgetary impacts.

Background and Previous Actions

Amendments to the Youth Commission (Commission) By-Laws require a three-fourths majority vote at any meeting of the Commission provided such amendment(s) is proposed at a preceding meeting, or is submitted in writing at a prior regular meeting of the Commission and is recorded in the minutes of such meeting. Such amendment(s) shall be subject to ratification by the City Council.

Staff proposed amendments to the Youth Commission By-Laws to align with Ordinance 2019-1441 approved by the Council on July 8, 2019. The amendments also include the addition of "Article V:Travel" as a result of a FY20 Budget Supplemental approved by the Council to send a delegation to the National League of Cities Congressional Conference in Washington DC. Staff also recommended additional language changes throughout the By-Laws for consistency.

The Proposed By-Law amendments were proposed and reviewed at the Youth Commission meeting on [August 28, 2019](#) and approved at the following meeting on [September 25, 2019](#) by unanimous vote. The City Attorney reviewed and approved the By-Law changes on September 30, 2019.

Staff Analysis

Staff recommends that Council ratify the amendments to the Youth Commission By-Laws.
