6.1 <u>16-5844</u> <u>GOODYEAR CITY HALL PUBLIC ART</u> RECOMMENDATION:

Approve the expenditure of \$20,000 for public art at Goodyear City Hall.

PURPOSE:

The Goodyear Arts and Culture Commission recommends the inclusion of public art at Goodyear City Hall and requests that Council approve the expenditure of \$20,000 to include artwork in the City Hall entrance enhancement project. The artwork will take into consideration the building's architecture as well as the city's commitment to sustainability and the environment. (Guylene Ozlanski, Arts and Culture Coordinator)

7.1 <u>16-5831</u> <u>APPOINTMENTS TO THE YOUTH COMMISSION</u> RECOMMENDATION:

Applications were solicited and the Council Subcommittee for Boards, Commissions and Committees met to review submissions, interview applicants and make a recommendation for appointment of Commission members. 7.2 16-5868 REAPPOINT REPRESENTATIVE TO POLICE PUBLIC SAFETY RETIREMENT BOARD RECOMMENDATION:

- Reappoint Justin Hughes as the Police Public Safety Personnel representative to the Police Public Safety Personnel Retirement Board, for a four year term, ending July 31, 2020.
- 2. City Clerk will administer the Oath of Loyalty.

PURPOSE:

The Public Safety Personnel Retirement Board for Police is to administer the retirement plan for Police employees. The Board reviews retirement and new hire applications and will meet at least twice a year. By law, there must be two sworn police officers and two Goodyear Citizens on the Board. 7.3 <u>16-5863</u> <u>SERIES 7 LIQUOR LICENSE FOR SNEAKY PETE BILLIARDS, LLC.</u> RECOMMENDATION:

Approve a request from Mario Cardona, owner/agent for Sneaky Pete Billiards, LLC, for a Series 7 Person Transfer/Location Transfer Liquor License #07074004, located at 15450 W. Goodyear Boulevard North #135, Goodyear, Arizona 85338 (generally located on the northeast corner of Estrella Parkway and Goodyear Boulevard North).

PURPOSE:

Mr. Cardona has applied for a Person Transfer/Location Transfer Series 7 (Beer and Wine Bar) Liquor License with the Arizona Department of Liquor Licenses and Control. He anticipates opening the new Sneaky Pete Billiards business at the end of July, 2016. (Sue Brungardt, Deputy City Clerk)

PURPOSE:

GMP II includes but is not limited to, epoxy flooring, window coverings, carpet and tile, plumbing fixtures, landscaping, cabinetry and counter tops, appliances, carports, audio visual systems, lockers, paint and signage.
