#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Receive information regarding the FY13-14 department base budgets to include current operations and services provided. Fire, Development Services, Information Technology (IT), and Parks & Recreation will provide presentations at this work session.

#### **PURPOSE:**

This work session and the information to be presented is part of the FY14-15 budget planning process. The purpose is to provide information to the Council and the public regarding the current base budgets for key departments in the City and the programs and services that are supported with existing budgets.
