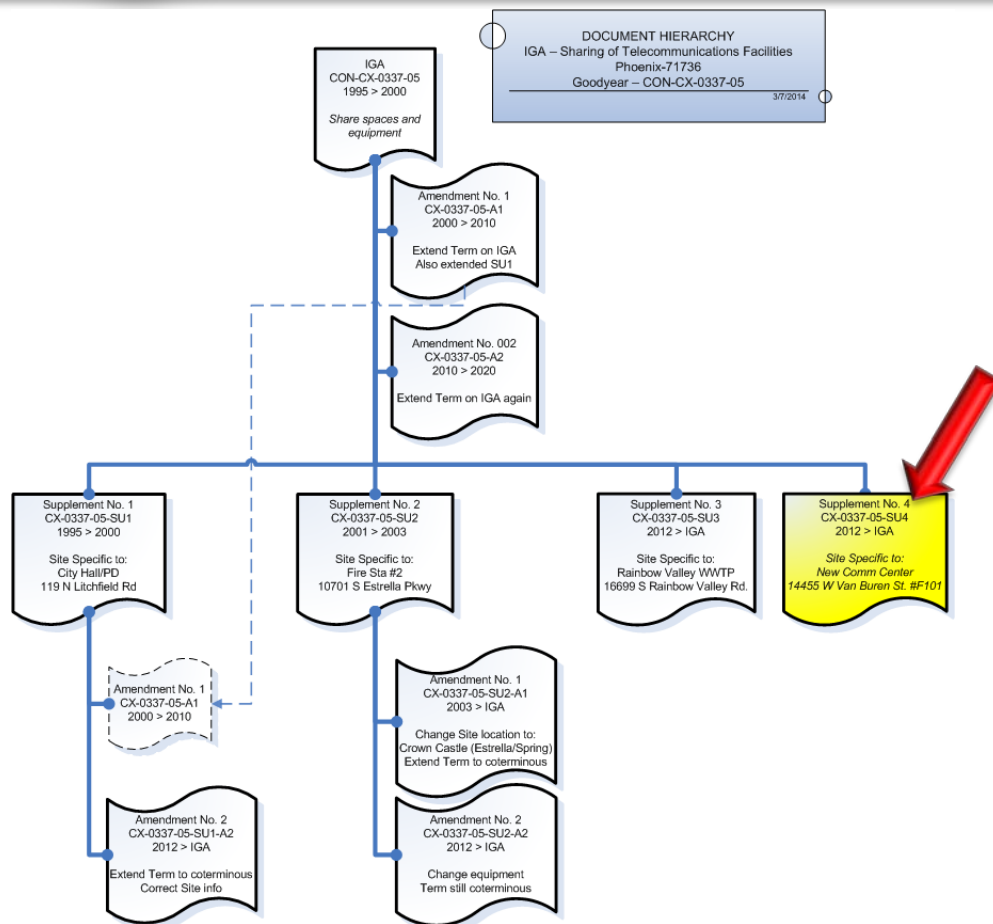


IGA OVERVIEW

- IGA CON-CX-0337-05: Sharing of Telecommunications Facilities
 - Executed between Goodyear and Phoenix in 1995
 - Allows our agencies to share radio tower sites and support facilities
 - Originally put in place to cover equipment and the tower at our current communications center on Litchfield Rd
 - Has expanded through additional supplements to also cover:
 - Fire Station #2
 - Rainbow Valley WWTP Tower

- IGA does not commit us to any costs or promise of space use, it only makes it possible
- We are meeting with Phoenix Fire to discuss relocating new radio equipment to our new Telecommunications Center and tower
- Phoenix is still responsible for the installation and maintenance of their equipment at any shared facility
- Dovetails with the Regional Wireless Cooperative project



RWC OVERVIEW

- Regional 'Interoperable' System
 - Police and Fire Departments able to communicate directly
 - Multiple cities participating
 - Goodyear, Glendale, Avondale, Phoenix, Buckeye, City of Maricopa, Chandler, El Mirage, Surprise, Peoria, Tempe, Scottsdale, others coming soon
 - Access to other agencies during critical or planned events
 - MCSO, DPS, Tolleson, FBI, ADOT, CBP, ...
 - GPD expansion from 3 channels up to 13, plus 128 other talkgroups



RWC OVERVIEW

- Goodyear became partner in 2009
- RWC now working with east valley agencies to bring the 'TRWC' back into the fold
- Radios will work across the valley, roaming from site to site similar to how cell phones work



GO-LIVE

- Planned date for moving 911 and dispatching operations to the new center is May 6th
- Planned date for moving Police radio operations to the RWC system is May 7th
