RECOMMENDATION:

Execute Intergovernmental Agreement (JPA 14-0004967) with the State of Arizona for access and exchange of traffic crash data with the Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT).

PURPOSE:

All municipalities are required to provide crash reports to ADOT, and the crash reports are input into the Accident Location, Identification, and Surveillance System (ALISS) database by ADOT Staff. Approval of this agreement will allow City Staff to access the ALISS database to obtain crash data for use in traffic analysis. In addition, it would also allow the Police Department to input crash data through this database in the future if the Goodyear Police Department determined that to be beneficial.

BACKGROUND AND COMMUNITY BENEFIT:

Municipalities currently provide crash reports to ADOT, and the information from the crash reports are entered into a database. Until recently, ADOT would provide the crash data to Cities for use in traffic safety analysis through a records request. ADOT no longer provides this service, and instead enters into agreements with Cities to allow access to the database. Approval of this agreement will allow City Staff to access crash data in a spreadsheet format that is very efficient for crash analysis. This data is used Traffic Engineers and Police Officers evaluate safety issues and implement measures to mitigate concerns.

PREVIOUS ACTIONS AND DISCUSSION:

There has been no previous action or discussion on this topic.
