- Impact Fee funded projects delayed
- > 3 projects to Asset Management
- No pre-August 2014 impact fee resources remain for Van Buren: Estrella to Sarival project
- Partially funded Yuma Rd Bridge & Bullard wash cancelled
- Prior approved changes for Goodyear Blvd
- \$70,000 moved between 2 streets fiber projects to capitalize on outside resources available in FY16

## PROPOSAL FOR DISCUSSION

- Do not fund \$2M in Undesignated Asset Management in FY16
- Use \$2M to fund:
  - \$1.7M loan to impact fees to advance Sarival: I-10 to Van Buren
  - \$0.3M to design Van Buren: Estrella to Sarival; Use impact fees payback on Sarival project loan to fund remaining \$1.7M in FY18

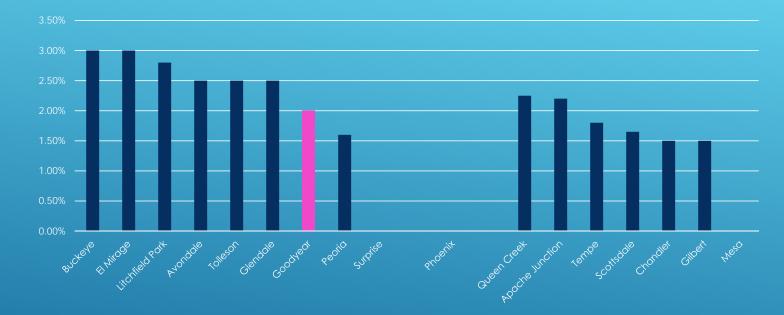
