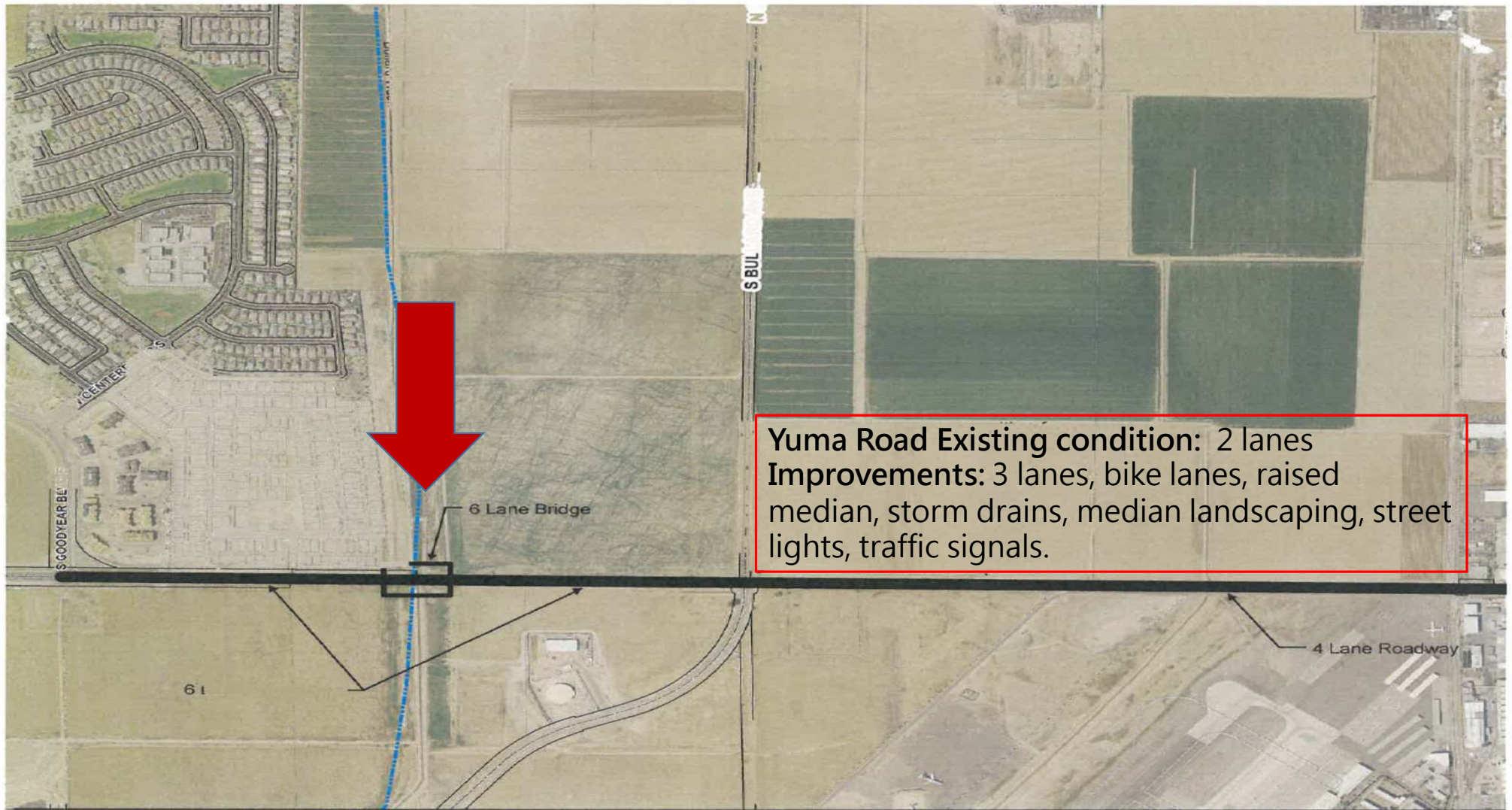


Yuma Road Bridge Improvements

April 27, 2015



Yuma Road Existing condition: 2 lanes
Improvements: 3 lanes, bike lanes, raised median, storm drains, median landscaping, street lights, traffic signals.

Key Events

2003: MAG awarded \$746,000 of federal funds to the City to design the Yuma Rd. Bridge;

March 2009: Yuma Rd. Bridge was unfunded in the 5-Year CIP. It was programmed in the “out years” for \$5.2M;

June 2009: ADOT Environmental Group determined that the project meets the criteria of an Environmental Categorical Exclusion (CE);

Cont.

September 2009: ADOT Environmental Group submitted the project's CE to FHWA for approval;

December 2009: Mayor and City Council accept the Rights of Way for the Yuma Road Bridge;

October 2013: ADOT requests a formal letter from the City explaining why the project has not advanced into construction;

Cont.

November 2013: the City sent a letter to ADOT explaining why the project has not been constructed. Included in the letter was when the ROW was acquired by the City and approved by ADOT.

June 2014: FY2014-15 Annual Budget approved including authorization of \$1M for the project in FY2019-2024;

April 2015: ADOT notification to the City of fund de-obligation for the project design.

Next Steps:

- Financial capacity for repayment of design services (\$413,780.32) will be provided in FY16 annual budget recommendation;
- Review of legal obligation for repayment will be completed by the City Attorney;
- A recommendation will be forwarded to Council once request for repayment is received from ADOT.
