PURPOSE:

The District Board will conduct a Public Hearing to receive comments regarding any of the proposed expenditures for the Cortina Community Facilities District (City of Goodyear, Arizona) for Fiscal Year Beginning July 1, 2016 and Ending June 30, 2017, as required by law. After the Public Hearing, the District Board will consider a resolution to approve the final budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

BACKGROUND AND PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

The District Board is required to adopt the Cortina Community Facilities District's (City of Goodyear, Arizona) budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

The Cortina Community Facilities District (City of Goodyear, Arizona) is generally located between Sarival Avenue, Yuma Road, Broadway Road and Estrella Parkway.

The tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 was presented to the District Board on May 23, 2016. It was approved by resolution CORTINACFD RES 16-049. The final budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 is exactly the same as the approved tentative budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

CURRENT POLICY:

Exhibit A of the resolution is the statements and schedules presented for District Board adoption as the final budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. The final budget for the Cortina Community Facilities District (City of Goodyear, Arizona) is \$378,162.

Although General Obligation bonding authority remains for this District, there are no expenditures budgeted in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 for capital improvement projects and there are no new bonds planned to be sold during this time.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

The Finance staff has reviewed the final budget for the Cortina Community Facilities District and finds that it is in compliance with state law and city policies. They are in support of the proposed action.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

The combined property tax rate is not expected to exceed \$2.85 per \$100 of net limited assessed valuation. However, such rate may exceed \$2.85 per \$100 of net limited assessed valuation depending upon the final net limited assessed valuation certified in August 2016. The combined property tax is collected and used for Operations and Maintenance in Fiscal Year 2016-2017 and Debt Service payments in Calendar Year 2016. The approximate combined property tax rate projected using the preliminary net limited assessed valuation information from February 2016 is \$2.3824 per \$100 of net limited assessed valuation.

Of the combined property tax rate, (i) \$2.0824 per \$100 of net limited assessed valuation is used to pay the general obligation bond debt service payments and (ii) \$0.30 per \$100 of net limited assessed valuation is used for operations and maintenance for the District. The total proposed Fiscal Year 2016-2017 final budget is \$378,162.
