## I. BIDDER QUESTIONS/ANSWERS

Q1: Please clarify discrepancies between bid tab quantities and bid item descriptions of electrical (traffic, street lighting) scope items with information indicated on the APS construction documents.

A1: Please refer to the revised bid tab for clarifications on bid item quantities, bid numbers and descriptions for electrical items. Some items shown on APS plans have quantity discrepancies when measured against existing and proposed improvements and have been revised as shown. No modifications to the construction documents are anticipated.

Q2: Can you please clarify what is required for Item 471.60048- ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT/INSTALLATIONS (APS) (1) LS? The plans and specifications provide no information.

A2: Refer to addition to special provisions below - ITEM 471.60048 ELECTRICAL EQUIPMENT/ INSTALLATIONS (APS). Work related to this bid item is for Contractor to coordinate and install APS provided materials/equipment as part of the APS design.

Q3: Item 471.61214 - PVC ELECTRICAL CONDUIT 2-2.5" (W/ NYLON PULL ROPE) (STREETLIGHTING) is calling for (90) LF. On the street lighting plans the quantity appears to be closer to (45) LF. However, I believe this item to also be a partial duplicate to Item 471.61218 PVC ELECTRICAL CONDUIT (W/ NYLON PULL ROPE) (STREETLIGHTING) (APS TRENCH S1). Please clarify.

A3: Refer to revised bid tab quantities and descriptions and revised special provisions below. These two item have been combined to simplify scope. Contractor will be required to install $2-2.5^{\prime \prime}$ conduit from mainline trench to $j$-box at all streetlight locations per APS requirements on recent projects.

Q4: Item 471.60046 - PULL BOX (STREET LIGHTING) (APS PROVIDED) is calling for (9) EA. The street lighting plans call for (10) ea. I believe someone only counted (1) at Sta. 105+91 but the street lighting plans show (2) for (1) new light pole. The APS plans only show (1) j-box at this location. Can you clarify are (9) required based on the APS plans or (10) as shown on the street lighting plans?

A4: J-box symbol north of Sta 105+91 indicates point of delivery/connection to APS electrical circuit/grid and is not anticipated to require a $j$-box (unless required by APS during construction). Bid quantity for this item is correct at 9 each.

Q5: Please clarify the two below bid items for traffic signals. The specials reflect a measurement and payment of per linear foot of trench yet the quantity listed in the bidding schedule reflects linear foot of conduit required and not trench length.

A5: Refer to revised bid tab quantities and descriptions and revised special provisions below. All quantities for trenching/conduit shall be measured and paid per the trench type as indicated in the revised special provision item below and revised bid tab.

Q6: Can you provide a copy of the Existing TOPO file? i.e. LandXML
A6: TOPO file/LandXML files are not currently available.
Q7: Are there any CADD files available?
A7: CADD files are not currently available.

Q8: $\quad$ Structural Section \#2 shown on Sheet DT01 does not match C.O.G. STD DET G-3216 TYPE E that is referenced. The notes on C.O.G. STD DET G-3216 state that the AC section is 4 " minimum. SS \#2 AC section in the plans is only $3^{\prime \prime}$. Type E shows the AC section as $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right.$ Mix) over $2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{Mix}\right)$ and SS \#2 AC section in the plans shows $3^{\prime \prime}$ ( $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ Mix) only. Page 2 of the Special Provisions state that Goodyear standard details supersede the Construction Plans. Please Clarify.

A8: The 2012 version of the City of Goodyear standard details supersede construction plans. The 2012 Goodyear standard details show Type E pavement section is $3^{\prime \prime}$ ( $3 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ MIX), which is consistent with structural section \#2 of the construction plans.

Q9: Instruction to Bidders, Section 1. Subsection I. states: "...CD-ROM of the proposal containing all original documents." Can you provide a list of the original documents that will be needed to be included in the CD-ROM?

A9: Please include the entire IFB solicitation package and all solicitation amendments.

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Q10: Instruction to Bidders, Section 1. Subsection I. lists "References" to be tabbed. Is there a "References" form we are to use? What is to be included in the "References" tab?

A10: Contractor's IFB response shall contain tabs for the following pages: Offer and Acceptance, and Fee Schedule. References have been removed from the solicitation.

Q11: Please clarify and list which items are to be turned in with the Solicitation Package. Are the items from each section in the Instruction to Bidders to be turned in with the Solicitation Package? (i.e. Descriptive Literature, Personnel, etc.)
A11: Contractor shall include descriptive literature per Instructions to Bidders, item 5 and Item 13.
Q12: Instruction to Bidders, Section 13. Personnel. Please clarify which personnel need to be identified and which format it needs to be in.

A12: Please provide a complete list of key personnel assigned to work on this project. Include name, title, identify role, number of years with company and type of assignments. Notification must be submitted to the City if at any time during the term of the contract a change is made to key personnel.

Q13: Will the City of Goodyear provide a blank bid bond form for bidder to use?
A13: Example forms attached, bid bond, payment and performance bond.
Q14: In the Instruction of Bidders, page 3 of 38 , paragraph $1(I)$, what type of references is the city of Goodyear looking for?

A14: Refer to response provided under A10.
Q15: Sheet PV07 (page 19 of 50 ) in the plans does not have note 37 on the plans, but is called out under the construction notes list. Please clarify if note 37 is missing from the plan sheet or if note 37 should not have been added to the construction note list.

A15: Plan view note 37 should be deleted and replaced with note 32 for relocation of water service at station $91+44.14$.

Q16: Sheet PV07 (page 19 of 50 ) in the plans shows note 44 in the plan view, however there is no note 44 in the construction notes list. Also, there are two note 42 in the construction note list.
A16: Note 44 was correctly labeled in plan view, and calls for "RELOCATE BACK FLOW PREVENTER PER COG STD DET G-3350 AS SHOWN, NO ENCLOSURE". It was mislabeled as a duplicate note 42 in the construction note table.

Q17: Bid item 523.12125 - "U Shaped Headwall Per MAG STD DET 501 with Trash Rack Per MAG STD DET 502 with Painted Handrail Per MAG STD DET 145 Type $1^{1 "}$ is not shown in the plans. Please clarify where the headwall will be installed.
A17: Bid item 523.12125 is called out as construction note 10 on sheet DR01 (page 27 of 50)

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Q18: Sheet PV01 (page 13 of 50 ) in the plans, under removal note " "", a field review found that no concrete lined ditch exists in that location. Please confirm.
A18: Portions of concrete lined ditch may have been buried or removed with recent retention basin landscaping. Any remaining sections within City RM must be removed with this project.

Q19: Sheet PV01 (page 13 of 50 ) in the plans, under construction note 31, the bidder is to relocate a 2 " air release valve. However, a field review was not able to identify any air release valves in the area to relocate. Please clarify if the 2" air release valve is existing or new.

A19: Air release valve is located within existing meter box near edge of pavement, as indicated on the construction plans. Per City requirements, existing service line must be removed back to the main, a new continuous service line (of same size) shall be installed to accommodate relocation of air release valve/box to behind new sidewalk.

Q20: Can you tell me where I can get a plan holder list for this project?
A20: The City doesn't maintain a plan holders list.
Q21: Is there a soils report on this project?
A21: A soils report was not prepared for this project.
Q22: In "ITEM 483.00210 RELOCATE CCTV CAMERA TO NEW SIGNAL POLE W/ NEW HARDWARE (INCLUDES CONNECTION TO CITY ITS/FIBER SYSTEM)" it states "Contractor shall make all connections to the City of Goodyear ITS/Fiber system to provide a fully functioning CCTV Camera System." There is no information provided as to the existing ITS/Fiber system that we are supposed to connect to.
A22: Please refer to attached plan titled: ITS fiber as-builts.
Q23: They need to know if the traffic signal materials being provided by the City need be replaced by the successful contractor and those costs included for in the appropriate bid items.
A23: See the revised Bid Tab. The traffic signal materials provided by the city at the time of construction shall be ordered and replaced by the contractor. The Bid Tab item descriptions have been revised.

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Q24: On plan sheet 43 (of 50) (copy attached), a note states that the contractor is to provide and install structure panels, screws and bolts - are there specific details to determine the hardware?

A24: See the City of Tempe Details and contact a COG approved Modular Traffic Signal Structure supplier (Caid or JV Driver) for a detailed material list.

Q25: Also, same sheet; the contractor is to install "W32-1AZ" ( 36 " $\times 36$ ") on post Min 750 ' in advance of the signal: Are these costs to be included in the signal bid items, or the traffic control bid item?

A25: Delete the requirement to install "W32-1AZ" ( 36 " $\times 36$ ") on post before activating the traffic Signal intersection.

Q26: Bid Items 476.12525, 12526 and 12527 are based on City of Tempe Detail 'T-561'. That detail includes more than one assembly, which ones are we to use?
A26: Contact a COG approved Modular Traffic Signal Structure supplier (Caid or JV Driver) for a detailed material list.

Q27: The instructions to bidders section i. states that sales tax shall be indicated as a separate item. The fee schedule states that the city will pay all applicable taxes. The standard terms and conditions section 3.14 states that the contractor is responsible for all tax obligations. Is it the cities intent to pay all taxes and not have them included in the total project cost shown in the fee schedule?

A27: A line item for sales tax has been added to the bid schedule.

The electric power company at this intersection is Arizona Public Service (APS). The contractor shall contact Henry Miranda at 602-371-6605 at least thirty-days (30) prior to construction for APS service installation requirements and service point of delivery (POD). The Contractor, upon determining the POD, shall provide and install $2-1 / 2$ inch conduit from the POD to the meter pedestal cabinet and street light electrical conduit/circuits as specified on the plans.

The Contractor shall pothole conduit runs at locations where potential conflicts exist ahead of all underground work to allow for sufficient time to resolve any conflicts without impact to construction schedule. The cost associated with this item shall be incidental to the work and shall NOT have a separate pay item. Hand digging is considered a form of potholing and is included in the cost associated with this item.

Trenching, back filling, replacing pavement, temporary pavement/subgrade/subbase curb and gutter, sidewalk and any additional traffic control including steel plates are considered incidental to this item and not paid separately.

Trench/conduit crossing the roadway, concrete/asphalt driveways, any areas not being disturbed/reconstructed as part of this project, or areas where final improvements have previously be constructed shall be installed by directional boring, unless otherwise approved by the Project Manager.

Cox and CenturyLink will deliver conduit and fittings/sweeps to the Contractors yard or staging area for installation in common/joint trench (identified in APS plans and/or on streetlight plans). Contractor will be required to install this conduit as shown on their respective construction plans, as well as at locations shown in the APS plans, the cost of which is inclusive of the associated bid item.

Prior approval from the City is necessary to install conduit under existing pavement using an open trench. Open trench excavation shall be done in accordance with City of Goodyear requirements and per the construction plans.
