**SUBJECT:** Approve Intergovernmental Agreement with the Arizona Department of Public Safety for Goodyear police officers to work off-duty security services at the University of Phoenix Stadium.

**RECOMMENDATION:**

Approve and authorize the City Manager or his designee to execute the Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) between the Arizona Department of Public Safety (DPS) and city of Goodyear for Goodyear police officers to work off-duty at events occurring at the University of Phoenix Stadium.

**PURPOSE:**

The Goodyear Police Department seeks to assist DPS in working off-duty events at the University of Phoenix Stadium in Glendale as no single agency can support the security needs of the Stadium.

**BACKGROUND AND PREVIOUS ACTIONS:**

This IGA will provide additional off-duty opportunities to Goodyear police officers while assisting DPS to fulfill their need for additional law enforcement officers to work security at Stadium events.

The DPS maintains similar agreements with other law enforcement agencies across the valley. This IGA provides an avenue for the Goodyear Police Department to strengthen joint operations with experience and relationships not only with DPS but also with other participating cities.

In 2009, the city of Goodyear and city of Glendale entered into a three-year IGA for security and law enforcement services at the University of Phoenix Stadium. The IGA was renewed in 2012 for an additional three-year term which was due to terminate June 30, 2018. The city of Glendale has since given notice to terminate the contract in which DPS has accepted responsibility going forward.

**STAFF ANALYSIS:**

Off duty work is permitted, with written approval, per Goodyear Police Department policy as long as it does not interfere with the employee's performance or responsibilities to the Department. Goodyear PD is interested in remaining a partner with this coalition.

**FISCAL ANALYSIS:**

There is no fiscal impact to the city of Goodyear. During events at the Stadium, assigned officers are considered to be temporary employees of DPS for compensation purposes.
