SUBJECT: Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County for reciprocal waving of traffic control permit fees.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Authorize the City Manager or designee to execute an Intergovernmental Agreement with Maricopa County for reciprocal waiving of traffic control permit fees.

BACKGROUND AND PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

There are many locations in Goodyear where streets owned by Maricopa County are adjacent to streets owned by the City of Goodyear. When City or County work takes place on a street that is near the other agency's jurisdiction, it is common for a traffic control permit to be needed from the other jurisdiction.

On August 29, 2016 City Council adopted an update to the City's existing traffic control ordinance, which included waiving traffic control fees for projects funded by other federal, state, or local governments. Maricopa County does not currently have a similar waiver for other jurisdictions.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

As of August 29, 2016 the City of Goodyear currently waives traffic control fees for projects that are funded by other jurisdictions. Since Goodyear is currently required to pay for traffic control permits on County roadways, this agreement would provide a reciprocal benefit for projects in both jurisdictions. Benefit from the execution of this agreement would first be realized on the traffic signal construction project at Lower Buckeye Road and Cotton Lane, which is scheduled to begin construction in May 2017.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of this intergovernmental agreement, so that both Maricopa County and Goodyear do not charge traffic control permit fees to the other jurisdiction.
