

CITY	DOCK DOORS & LOADING BAYS
Mesa	PEP & LI districts: dock doors located on side or rear of buildings, may not face a public street or private street functioning as a public road; screened by min 8-ft masonry wall & opaque automated gates. GI & HI districts: ok on all sides. 50 feet from residential district or use
Chandler	Outside storage of equipment, vehicles & materials screened by 6-ft masonry wall. All service bays oriented or screened so as not to be visible from public street or adjoining residential area. Dock doors not referenced
Surprise	All service entrances & service yards in rear or side yard of principal use. No service drive or yard on a side adjoining a residential district
Tolleson	All loading, delivery & service bays screened from street view by 6-ft wood, brick, slump block, or masonry wall w/stucco or mortar wash
Glendale	Loading spaces or dock areas screened by min 8-ft masonry wall or berm & landscaping.
Avondale	Storage areas fully screened by concrete and/or masonry block walls and opaque gates
Buckeye	Dock doors not referenced
