#### **PROPOSED ACTION:**

Accept the Federal Fiscal Year 2017 Arizona Department of Homeland Security Grant Program Award in the amount of \$53,820 for the Goodyear Fire 2017 Urban Area Security Initiative Sustainment and Technology Update and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all documents related to the grant award and authorize a budget transfer to allow for the expenditure of the grant.

#### **BACKGROUND AND PREVIOUS ACTIONS:**

In FFY 2016 the Grant Program award of \$20,348 to purchase a Simulation and Training System to improve the hazardous materials identification during hazmat events.

In FFY 2015 the Grant Program award of \$50,000 funded three additional personnel to receive hazmat training, attend the National Homeland Security Conference and upgrade the software used in responding to hazardous incidents.

#### **STAFF ANALYSIS:**

The grant funds will provide training of additional hazmat technicians, broaden the knowledge and skills of current technicians and give the hazmat team tools and technology to be successful on hazardous materials and regional Chemical, Biological, Radiological, Nuclear and Explosives (CBRNE) incidents.

On August 29, 2017, the Office of General Counsel determined that the term and condition "Buy American and Hire American" does not apply to Department of Homeland Security grant programs. The FY 2017 Terms and Conditions have been revised accordingly (See attached grant notice).

### **FISCAL ANALYSIS:**

The current grant award of \$53,820 is on a reimbursement basis and is conditional upon receipt of proof of payment and applicable, accurate and complete reimbursement documents. There is no grant match requirement.

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# **RECOMMENDATION:**

Accept the UASI Grant Award of \$53,820 awarded by AZDOHS to the Goodyear Fire Department and authorize the City Manager or designee to execute all documents related to the grant award and authorize a budget transfer to allow for the expenditure of the grant.
