SUBJECT: Donation of a Surplus 2007 Chevrolet Police K-9 Tahoe to the Quartzsite Police Department.

PROPOSED ACTION:

Authorize the execution of a donation agreement, including any necessary related documentation, providing for the donation of the city's surplus 2007 Chevrolet Police K-9 Tahoe to the Quartzsite Police Department for use in emergency response.

BACKGROUND AND PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

The Quartzsite Police Department is a department of 14 employees (11 sworn officers and 3 civilians). They are currently in need of a vehicle for their K-9 Unit. Currently the Quartzsite Police Department utilizes a sedan patrol vehicle as a K-9 vehicle. This donation would allow them to safely patrol and respond to emergency calls for service.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

This is an 11-year old Police K-9 Tahoe that has most recently served as a spare vehicle for the K-9 Unit. It was replaced in the 2017-2018 budget year with a new 2017 Police Tahoe. The 2007 truck no longer meets Police Department standards as a spare K-9 vehicle. The Tahoe includes operational emergency lights and a full K-9 kennel, both of which have exceeded their service life expectancy with Goodyear.

Current procurement policy permits the donation of the vehicle as described. Public safety services and fleet services are not negatively impacted since the truck has been replaced.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

The estimated auction value of the 2007 Chevrolet Police Tahoe is between \$4,000 and \$7,000. Donation results in the foregoing of this revenue.

RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the execution of a donation agreement, including any necessary related documentation, providing for the donation of the city's surplus 2007 Chevrolet Police K-9 Tahoe to the Quartzsite Police Department for use in emergency response.
