AMENDMENTS TO CHAPTER 10 – HEALTH AND SANITATION OF THE GOODYEAR CITY CODE

10-2-2 RATES, FEES AND DEPOSITS.

(G) Unscheduled or Excessive Bulk Collections. Additional fees may be assessed for unscheduled or excessive volume pickup and disposal of bulk refuse. Bulk collection will be considered excessive when it exceeds two FIVE cubic yards of material per collection. The rates and charges for such services will be added to the monthly bill.

10-3-2 REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICES, LOCATION FOR PICKUP.

(A) Containers used for residential automated collection shall be placed for collection in an unobstructed passage, street, alley or curbside in accordance with the requirements of this article.

(B) Where there is an alley in the rear of the premises, the refuse container shall be placed immediately adjacent to the alley behind the property or in the alley in such a manner as not to impede vehicular access. The recycling container shall be placed at the curb in front of the premises as not to be hazardous to pedestrians or vehicles. **RESERVED**.

(C) Where there is no alley, cContainers shall be placed at the curb in front of the premises except at a corner lot where containers may be placed at the curb of the side street. Refuse and recycling containers may not be placed on sidewalks or curbing in any manner as to interfere with or be hazardous to pedestrians or vehicles. If more than one container is placed out for collection, the containers must have at least three feet of separation in order to accommodate automated collection. Containers should not be located closely to a parked vehicle, mailbox, fence, fire hydrant, plant materials, or other such restrictive objects in order to facilitate safe and efficient automated collection.

10-3-3 BULK COLLECTION SERVICES, LOCATION FOR PICKUP.

(B) Bulk. Bulk service shall only be provided to residential accounts that have an active sanitation account. This service is provided and included in the monthly rate for this service. Collections shall include items that cannot be placed inside a container due to size or content. Material placed out for bulk collection shall not exceed two FIVE cubic yards per each collection. Bulk material shall be placed out for collection only when designated by the City for the pickup of the specific material.

(E) Manner of Placement. Bulk collection piles shall be placed in neat stacks no farther than four feet from the sidewalk or curb edge; or on the street parallel to the curb line and in such a manner that does not obstruct vehicle or pedestrian traffic. For customers who receive alley service only, bulk shall be placed in neat stacks parallel to the property line and in such a manner that does not obstruct vehicle or pedestrian traffic. All piles shall be a minimum of five feet away from fences, cable junction boxes, electrical junction boxes, gas meters, water meter boxes, fire hydrants, mailboxes or any structure that may lead to property damage or injury.

10-4-2 REFUSE, PROHIBITIONS.

(C) Bulk Refuse. It is unlawful for customers to knowingly place bulk refuse curbside or in the alley-more than seven calendar days prior to the customer's scheduled bulk collection day.
