PROPOSED ACTION:

1. Conduct a public hearing to consider a recommendation for a Class A bingo license.
 - a. Open the Public Hearing
 - b. Staff Presentation
 - c. Receive Public Comments
 - d. Close the Public Hearing
2. Recommend approval to the Arizona Department of Revenue for a Class A bingo license, submitted by Kittie Day, representative of the PebbleCreek Ladies Golf Association (PCLGA), for bingo games to be held in the Tuscany Falls Country Club, located at 16222 Clubhouse Dr., Goodyear, Arizona 85395.

BACKGROUND AND PREVIOUS ACTIONS:

Kittie Day, applicant for the PCLGA, has applied for a new Class A bingo license to be located at 16222 Clubhouse Dr. The PCLGA plans to host a bingo game within the Tuscany Falls Country Club during a golf tournament on April 8, 2019.

The City Clerk's Office received the completed application on November 16, 2018. The application has been routed to the Police Department and the Development Services Department (Planning and Zoning, Code Compliance and Building Safety), and any comments are listed below.

Per A.R.S. § 5-404, this application must be approved by the local governing body prior to being submitted to the Arizona Department of Revenue (ADOR), which is the licensing authority for bingo licenses.

Currently, the only bingo license operating within the city of Goodyear is Community Bingo, which is conducted through the Goodyear White Tanks Rotary and the Buckeye Rotary at 3690 S. Estrella Pkwy, Suite 108, Goodyear, Arizona 85338. Community Bingo operates under a Class B license, which was originally approved by Council on July 11, 2011.

STAFF ANALYSIS:

Class A bingo licenses are generally obtained for recreational and social purposes, returning all gross receipts to the players in prizes. The PCLGA intends to have one event on April 8, 2019 utilizing this license; however, bingo licenses are valid for a year from the date issued. This license allows the holder to conduct bingo games for which the gross receipts do not exceed \$15,600 per year. The PCLGA intends to charge \$5.00 per card with 6 total games and return all money collected from the cards to the winners.

The City Council's recommendation of "Approval" or "Disapproval" will be forwarded to the ADOR.

FISCAL ANALYSIS:

The applicant has paid the \$5 fee to the city of Goodyear per the ADOR Bingo License Packet.

RECOMMENDATION:

Staff recommends approval of the Class A bingo license.
