Truck Route Definitions

- Truck Route – Streets upon which regional truck traffic is directed for through travel or local travel
- Regulated Trucks (Semi-trailers, box/platform trucks, hazardous material trucks, and other trucks greater than 18,000 pound weight rating)¹
- Local pick-up/deliveries – Must travel shortest route from truck route to point of delivery/pick-up

¹ Emergency vehicles, garbage trucks, school buses, transit buses, and recreational vehicles are excluded

Cotton Lane/Loop 303	From Camelback Road to MC 85
Dysart Road	From McDowell Road to Van Buren Street
Estrella Parkway	From McDowell Road to MC 85
Interstate 10	-
Jackrabbit Road/Tuthill Road	From MC 85 to Rainbow Valley Road
Litchfield Road	From McDowell Road to MC 85
MC 85	From Dysart Road to Citrus Road
McDowell Road	From Cotton Lane to Litchfield Road

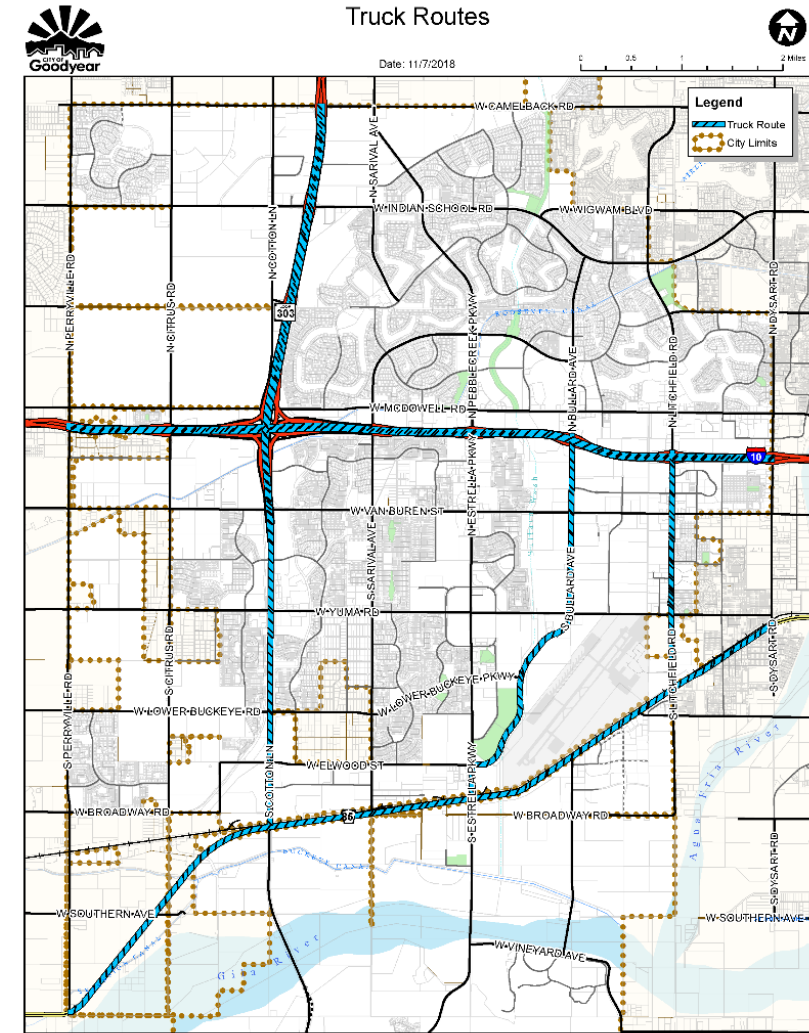

Elliot Road	From Estrella Parkway to Rainbow Valley Road
Estrella Parkway	From Vineyard Road to Elliot Road
Pebble Creek Parkway	From McDowell Road to Camelback Road

Proposed Truck Routes



Proposed routes:

- Cotton Ln - Van Buren St to MC 85
- SR 303 (State) – Throughout Goodyear
- I-10 (State) – Throughout Goodyear
- Litchfield Rd – I-10 to MC 85
- MC 85 (County) – Dysart Rd to Perryville Rd
- Bullard Ave – I-10 to Estrella Pkwy
- Estrella Pkwy – Bullard Ave/Elwood St to MC 85



Recommendation



- Adopt Ordinance 2018-1412, amending City Code Section 13-2-13 to update designated truck routes in Goodyear.
- Adoption of this ordinance will allow enforcement to occur for instances where truck route requirements are not followed.
