CITY COUNCIL ACTION REPORT

SUBJECT: Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with City of Glendale to Utilize Landfill

Summary: An Intergovernmental Agreement with the City of Glendale will allow city staff and Goodyear residents to utilize the Glendale Landfill for solid waste disposal.

Recommendation:

Authorize the Mayor or designee to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) with the City of Glendale, which would allow city staff and Goodyear residents the ability to utilize the Glendale Landfill.

Fiscal Impact: We anticipate we will take 95 percent of our bulk material to the Glendale landfill. The remaining bulk material would be taken to RAD's facility, as necessary.

Total estimated disposal cost for bulk material in FY2020 is \$147,100. Funding for the disposal cost is included in the Solid Waste operating fund base budget.

Background and Previous Actions

On January 28, 2019, Council authorized the City Manager to sign a contract and begin the transition process for the city's solid waste and recycling services with Right Away Disposal (RAD). This contract also includes disposal services for trash collected by all city departments at their transfer station located at 3000 South 19th Avenue, Phoenix. Goodyear residents will also be able to utilize the transfer station as part of the contract. Based on the proximity of the transfer station, staff began to research optional disposal locations.

Staff Analysis

The City of Glendale owns and operates a landfill located at 11488 West Glendale Avenue, Glendale. This location is closer to the city of Goodyear than the RAD transfer station. Additionally, Glendale has offered to provide the services at a negotiated rate of \$30.25 per ton

as opposed to \$38.00 per ton at the RAD transfer station. This IGA would expire on June 30, 2023 and fees will increase incrementally on an annual basis. The City of Glendale plans to approve this IGA at an upcoming council meeting.
