

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-1452

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AMENDING CHAPTER 3, CODE OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, BY ADDING ARTICLE 3-15 AND AMENDING 3-14-13; ADOPTING TERM LIMITS FOR BOARDS, COMMISSIONS AND COMMITTEES; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND CODES, CORRECTIONS, SEVERABILITY AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, City Council approved a Committee Appointment Process on November 28, 2011 that established a two-term limit; and

WHEREAS, the Council Subcommittee for Boards, Commissions and Committees have identified a need to have more terms available for committees that are more technical in nature; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Goodyear wish to establish a three-term limit for those committees;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GOODYEAR, MARICOPA COUNTY, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT TO CHAPTER 3, ADDING SECTION 3-15 OF THE GOODYEAR CITY CODE

Article 3-15 is hereby added as follows:

3-15 Term Limits

- (A) Unless otherwise referenced in Subsection (B) below, members appointed to Boards, Commissions and Committees shall have a two-term limit.
- (B) Members appointed to the following Boards, Commissions and Committees shall have a three-term limit:
 - (1) Board of Adjustment
 - (2) Fire/Building/Code Enforcement Appeals Board
 - (3) Industrial Development Board
 - (4) Public Improvement Corporation
 - (5) Public Safety Personnel Retirement Board – Police
 - (6) Public Safety Personnel Retirement Board – Fire
 - (7) Self-Insured Healthcare Trust Board

SECTION 2. AMEND ARTICLE 3-14-13 SELF-INSURED HEALTHCARE TRUST BOARD: BOARD; APPOINTMENT; TERMS

Amend 3-14-13 (F) as follows:

Delete: A Trustee may be reappointed to no more than one additional consecutive term.

SECTION 3. REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR CODES

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance or any part of the code adopted herein by reference are hereby repealed upon the effective date of this ordinance.

SECTION 4. CORRECTIONS

The City Attorney, City Clerk, the codifiers of the ordinance and their respective designees are authorized to make necessary clerical corrections to this ordinance, including but not limited to, the correction of scrivener's/clerical errors, references, numbers, sections/subsection numbers and any references thereto.

SECTION 5. SEVERABILITY

If any section, subsection, clause, phrase, or portion of this ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions therein.

SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall become effective as prescribed by law.
