Arizona Prop 207



SMART AND SAFE ARIZONA ACT

- Approved by Arizona voters on November 3, 2020
- Legalized the sale, possession and use of non-medicinal marijuana
- Set forth legally permissible amounts for possession
- Established age requirements for purchase, use, and possession
- Authorized AZ Department of Health Services to issue licenses and establish rules for marijuana establishments

CHAPTER 11 SECTION AMENDMENTS

ADDS section 11-1-38 which would:

- Prohibit smoking marijuana where smoking tobacco is prohibited
- Prohibit marijuana use or possession on city property
- Prohibit smoking, cultivation, manufacturing of marijuana in public places and open spaces
- Prohibit smoking marijuana at city parks and on city trails
- Add definitions related to marijuana, marijuana related products, and to ensure consistency with Goodyear's definition of smoking

Proposed Code Amendments



CHAPTER 11 SECTION AMENDMENTS

ADDS section 11-1-38 which would also:

- Prohibit non-licensed persons and entities from engaging in the retail sale of marijuana
- Prohibit the delivery of marijuana within Goodyear city limits (unless otherwise authorized by State law or regulations)
- Regulate personal use of marijuana at the personal residence
- Limit disposal of marijuana to legally permissible amounts
- Includes penalty provisions

CHAPTER 10 SECTION AMENDMENTS

AMENDS EXISTING section 10-1-1 (Definitions) to define all marijuana as a hazardous waste to ensure proper disposal.

- Applicable to marijuana establishments and dispensaries
