Section F(1)(a) of those procedures requires that an applicant provide written medical evidence to support an application for an accidental disability.

*We have been provided documentation from Estrella Parkway Medical Center, but not from the treating doctor.

Although we do have records from a Nurse Practitioner and Doctor of Chiropractic, there is a lack of medical doctor documentation as required Pursuant to A.R.S. § 38-847(F) and Fire and Police Board Rules of Procedure. There is a letter from a medical doctor, but there is no record that the medical doctor treated Mr. Bishop. We have been provided documentation from Estrella Parkway Medical Center but not from the treating doctor. There is lack of evidence that the injury is work related.
