## 4.3 Mobile Museum in Schools Program Update (All)

Coordinator Ozlanski provided an update to the committee about the Mobile Museum in the Schools

**Subcommittee** 

(MMIS) program. Staff is working with Dr. Kyann McMillie, Dr. Denise Bates, and the Three Rivers Historical Society to modify the existing exhibits in the Mobile Museum to make them more applicable in a school setting.

Project partners are developing curriculum, digital media, print media, and an oral history component that will be based in education state standards for educators to use Goodyear History in their classrooms. The MMIS will be available for educators to borrow from Goodyear Arts and Culture in the 2018/19 school year.

4.4 Explore Gaps in Programming and Consider New "Innovative" Programs to Add to Line-Up (All)

Committee Members discussed possible gaps in the current programing and discussed innovative ways to add new programming that would engage participants.

- -Committee Members suggested creative writing workshops or a series that would include classes on writing "Memoirs". Committee Member Donovan recommended reaching out to Dr. David Wilson to connect with the local "book writers" club for recommendations on possible lecturers for the program. -Committee Members discussed how the Arts and Culture Commission could become a grant-giving organization. Committee Members Donovan, Olson and Lambert asked that this item be added to the agenda of a future meeting.
- -Committee Members discussed further developing the "Artist in Schools" program. Committee Member Lambert recommended using the Arizona Commission on the Arts "Poets in the Schools" program as a model of how to effectively offer an "Artist in the Schools" program that would be accessible to Goodyear local schools.
