2. Discuss Ballet Under the Stars

Administrator Ozlanski provided an update about the impacts COVID-19 is having on planning. Ballet AZ, Newland Communities and Goodyear will make a decision on August 1, 2020 about whether the event will be held in September. Commissioner Privette and Chairman Jones inquired about possible options to host Ballet Under the Stars in a non-traditional format. 3. Discuss Chalk Art in the Park

Chairman Jones shared an update about the 2019 event. The committee decided to make a final decision on October 1, 2020 on whether the event could be held. If COVID-19 is still impacting the planning of special events Chalk Art in the Park planned for November 7, 2020 will be held virtually.

4. Review Past Special Events

Administrator Ozlanski provided a brief overview of past events the Arts and Culture Commission have been involved in including Art in Alive, Tale of Two Cities, Art of Culture and Art Bash.

To encourage a stronger development of the performing arts in Goodyear the following events are proposed to strengthen community and enhance quality of life in Goodyear. Arts and Culture has budget to provide the following events in FY2021. Events are being explored and decisions are being made to consider the health and safety of participants and the public. If allowable the following programs may move forward:

- c. Holiday Concert proposed December 12-13, 2020
