Public Art (Jennifer Barnes)

Commissioner Cross, chairman of the Communications and Advocacy Sub-Committee, is planning a meeting before the end of the calendar year. Commissioner Glenn, chairperson of the Education and Programs Sub-Committee, gave a brief summary of the COVID-19 impact on 2021 programming and plans to transition to a virtual platform. The Hot Coffee Lecture series will begin this month and if it is successful it will continue to run throughout the year. Commissioner Jones, chairperson of the Events and Festivals Sub-Committee, reported the committee had recently met and plan to move forward with events including three new ones. The events will take place with COVID-19 modifications which could mean a hybrid with a limited audience and a streaming element, completely virtual or in-person as intended. Commissioner Barnes, chairperson of the Public Art Sub-Committee, reviewed the artists selected for current public art projects. Blessing Handcock was commissioned for the Civic Square public art piece. For the Goodyear 75 heART of Goodyear project the following West Valley artists were selected: Ester Beler Woodrich 1940, Jenita Landrum-Bittles 1950, Team Turner 1960, Jessi Kerr 1980, Oliverio Balcells 1990, Emma Garcia 2000, Susan Rosell 2010, AnnMarie Perry 2020 and Nathan Carmichael Future. CoLab Studio was chosen for the public art project for Fire Station 188.

### **NEW BUSINESS**

Message from the Chairman (Fran Fee)

Chairperson Fee took a moment to appreciate the commissioners and thank them for their adaptability and perseverance to continue promoting arts and culture in Goodyear during this pandemic.

Approve Name for Goodyear Recreation Campus Artwork (Jennifer Barnes)

Administrator Ozlanski explained that the original name proposed by the artist for the public art installation at the Goodyear Recreation Campus had potential to be taken out of context sending a message that is not in alignment with the City's core beliefs and values. The artist put together a list of names for the commission to select a new one. Each commissioner gave their top five choices and two names emerged as most popular. There was not a clear consensus between the two and it was decided to ask the artists to make the final decision.

MOTION BY Commissioner Love, SECONDED BY Commissioner Privette, to have the artist of the public art for the Goodyear Recreation Campus decide between Chasing the Stars and Orbital Engine for the name of the piece. The motion carried by the following vote:
