2. Advocacy and Programs & Planning Subcommittees Updates (Chairman Landefeld)

Chairman Landefeld provided an Advocacy subcommittee update:

- -Landefeld stated the subcommittee focus at this time, is to promote city events by social media platforms.
- -Landefeld did an InstaStory of the Fall Festival; hashtag posted pics of yard signs for Veteran's Day; and will promote Goodyear Glows on social media.
- -Landefeld stated that Arts and Culture Administrator Guylene Ozlanski attended the subcommittee meeting and talked about some ideas on how the subcommittees can collaborate by sharing each commission's events and attend the commission meetings.
- -Landefeld stated that Ozlanski gave an overview of the Arts and Culture events for the year.

Parks and Recreation Manager David Seid thanked the commissioners for their flexibility and trying to attend meetings during the pandemic, and now moving forward to 2021, he asked for an update on the commissioners' position status.

- -Seid asked for confirmation from the commissioners, that have terms ending in December and eligible for reappointment, if they plan to submit a reappointment application to continue to serve on the Parks and Recreation Advisory Commission: Chairman Landefeld confirmed; Commissioner Stephens confirmed, Commissioner Wilson confirmed and alternate Hohman confirmed that she will apply to become a commissioner.
